LAKE COUNTY FAIR 2010 SLOT CLASS RULES

This year horse owners and exhibitors will again have the opportunity to purchase a "slot" for two different events, the Western Pleasure Slot Class and the Hunter Under Saddle Slot Class, to be held at the Open show at Lake County Fair on August 21, 2010.

Slots are available for a one time purchase only and all owners of the slots are required to pay a sustaining fee each year. Slot owners own the slot for their event for life. Slot owners may lease their slots on an individual basis however notification has to be made to the Slot secretary and lessee must comply with all stated rules. Slot owners who wish to sell their slots must sell them through the Slot secretary who will maintain a wait list.

Horse show exhibitors who wish to purchase a slot or wish to be placed on a waiting list for any slot that falls unpaid should contact Lori Urbancsik, Lake County Fair Board, at lcf@mwwweb.com.

Rules:

There will be a maximum number of 20 slots per each of the two slot classes sold for 2010.

Horse owner and/or exhibitor must paid \$50.00 slot ownership fee to own the slot.

2010 slot fee due by May 1st and paid each subsequent year to maintain ownership. Check to be made payable to the Lake County Agricultural Society. The first twenty (20) paid entries with completed Slot Owner Entry Form received (based on postmark) will fill each class. All others will be returned. Horse Declaration Form must be completed and submitted by July 1st (postmarked). Form to be mailed to the Lake County Fair Office, at the address above. After this date no change of horses will be allowed. No Exceptions.

Payback will be based on the number of slots sold with 100% payout for 2010. Each class will pay three (3) places.

The western horse may be shown one-handed in a bridle or two-handed in snaffle/bosal and follow legal guidelines for this equipment as defined by AQHA.
