Notice of Required Rabies Vaccination

Proof of rabies immunization will be required of any animal which:

- Originates from those counties in which the Ohio Department of Health has enacted a rabies quarantine.
- and is an animal for which a licensed vaccine is available. (Presently horses, cattle, sheep, dogs, cats and ferrets)

All dogs must be accompanied by a certificate of vaccination for rabies.

Proof of immunization must be provided by a licensed, accredited Veterinarian. Rabies immunization must be administered at least 14 days prior to the opening day of the fair. (21 days for any animal to be sold at the 4-H Livestock Auction)

Please contact your veterinarian at your earliest convenience to initiate the rabies vaccination program.

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
